## Registration

Registration will close when capacity has been reached or no later than May 12. Enrollment is for all strings (violin, viola, cello, and bass), orchestral woodwinds (flute, oboe (including English horn), bassoon, Bb clarinet (including bass clarinet), orchestral brass (Bb trumpets, F horns, trombones, tubas), and percussion.

The numbers of woodwinds, brass and percussion will be limited to balance with the orchestra. All wind and percussion players should be at an intermediate skill level or better. In addition, winds and percussion players are requested to answer some brief questions regarding your experience, especially in orchestra settings (see next page). Your responses will be reviewed, and if we feel that you will be a good fit for the orchestra, you will be invited to proceed with your registration. Waiting lists will be kept in the event of cancellations.

Sectionals will be a combination of working on the full orchestra music as well as 'string only' pieces or wind ensemble pieces, at the discretion of the conductors. Small groups may be mixed strings, strings & winds, woodwind, brass and/or percussion chamber ensembles. These will be organized based upon your interest.

## Bellinger Hall Retreat Center Accommodations Package

Bellinger Hall offers a comfortable dormitory-style residence atmosphere. Each room has two single beds, two desks, two wardrobe cabinets, all appropriate linens/toiletries, and a shared bath between two rooms. If you book a single or double occupancy with a private bath, the room that shares the bath will be left vacant, which makes this a more expensive option. Rooms do not have telephones, televisions or alarm clocks. Rooms in Bellinger Hall are convenient to the dining area and some of the rehearsal spaces. (continued on next page)

## Hotels, Bed and Breakfast, and the Campground

Chautauqua has wonderful hotels and B&Bs with good off-season rates. There is also a good campground nearby. Rates listed at this website are weekly summer rates—rates for this pre-season camp may be lower. If you book a room at Bellinger Hall, your meals are included in that price. If you are not staying at Bellinger, you will probably want to choose the Commuter Meal Package. Meal times are the best times to meet people from other New Horizons groups. If you stay at a B&B, ask them if you can have a price that does not include breakfast, or ask if they can serve breakfast at 7:30 or earlier so that you can get to your 8:30 class.

## Non-playing Guests

Non-playing guests (we call you '*music critics*') are most welcome to join us; we love an audience. No tuition fee, just room & board. And during times that you don't wish to sit and listen to our rehearsing, there are wonderful touring opportunities (see the 'tourchautauqua.com' link above), or congregate in Bellinger Dining and set up a bridge or Mahjong game, or just enjoy the beauty of the lake. On the registration form, you can fill in an activity which you would like to do, and perhaps we can set you up with others of like interests.

## Registration

**First.** Write to me, Ron Berry, at [berryr@verizon.net](mailto:berryr@verizon.net) and tell me your instrument, and answer the following questions. I will try to get back to you in about 48 hours regarding availability.

**Strings:** We welcome string players of all skill levels! To help us organize the sections, please include the following information in your response to me:

How long have you played your instrument?

Do you play regularly in any ensembles? Please define.

If you have studied from Suzuki books, please tell us the most advanced book you have used.

Name some pieces you're playing now or have recently played.

For violinists, would you feel more comfortable playing violin 1 or violin 2? Either?

**Woodwinds/Brass/Percussion:** please include the following information in your response to me:

How long have you played your instrument?

How much do you practice?

Do you take lessons?

Have you ever played in an orchestra before?

Do you play in one now?

Can you confidently play an independent part by yourself?

Could you play a solo in an orchestra piece?

Wait for confirmation from Ron Berry before going to step 2.

**Second.** If requesting accommodations at Bellinger Hall, email your request to Carly Davis at [cdavis@ciweb.org](mailto:cdavis@ciweb.org). She will let you know if the room type you request is available and reserve it for you if it is. If it is not, consider other choices. See the rates for Bellinger Hall and food plans on the registration form (next page). If you skip this step and mail in your registration, you may find that the room type you request is not available and you will need to start all over.

**Third.** Mail in your camp registration with payment for the instructional fee and for your meals and room, if any, at Bellinger. Your room request at Bellinger **will be held for seven (7) days** after you register by email. After that, your room request will automatically delete if your payment is not received by Chautauqua. You will receive a confirmation email from Chautauqua when your payment is received and your registration is complete.

**Cancellation Policy.** Refunds for cancellations before May 19th, 2017 will be honored less a service charge of \$50.00 per person. There will be NO REFUND on cancellations on or after May 19th, 2017, **regardless of circumstance**.
